Malcolm was born in 1928 at Wimbledon the only child of Gilbert and Georgina. His father was an accountant and company director. Malcolm won a special place scholarship at 11 years. He went to Tiffins School Kensington and then with the family evacuating to North Wales owing to the London area wartime raids, Friars School, Bangor. He excelled at most subjects, particularly Mathematics and English. In sport the mile was his distance and his school record stood for fifteen years after his departure.

As Flight sergeant of the school Air Training Corps it was only natural for him to choose the Royal Air Force for his 2 years national service. During his service he was, latterly, in charge of a Radar Station, RAF Danby Beacon, North Yorkshire. It was here that he met his future Wife Hazel at a Hunt Ball.

On leaving the Air Force in 1948, and with dentistry in mind, a year at University College, Bangor, Malcolm completed the formalities for admission to the Royal Dental Hospital, Leicester Square, London where he qualified in 1955. He entered a dental practice in Letchworth Garden City where he worked until his retirement in 1990.

Some six months before he qualified he married in Mayfair his beloved Hazel. They were married for 42 years and had a son, Callum, and a daughter Hilary of whom they were inordinately proud.

Outside professional life he joined the Round Table and eventually became the National Councillor for Hertfordshire over two years. A member of Rotary and a keen Freemason he entered many Orders. The Anglican Church saw him acting as a councillor and treasurer and serving on the Diocesan Board.

In 1991 Malcolm and Hazel decided to live in Cyprus and built a lovely villa in Peyia in the Paphos area, where they lived happily until Hazel's untimely death in 1997.

In Cyprus, Malcolm was a founder Vice Chairman of a mixed Lions Club. He taught tai Chi for a number of years. He served on the Anglican Church Council for some years before moving to the Roman Catholic Church on several matters of principal. and enjoyed Bridge, Backgammon, swimming and walking.

After Hazel's death Malcolm and Teresa got together and, having sold his villa have latterly lived in two hill villages of Lasa and Drinia respectively.

Malcolm passed away peacefully at Paphos General hospital on 12 June 2014

which he loved with so much affection.
